

State 4-H awards given to Lancaster Co. youths

UNIVERSITY PARK - Two Lancaster County young adults, who have compiled outstanding records in 4-H work, are state contest winners in the 1978 4-H National Awards Program.

Named were Deborah Enders, of Lancaster, state winner in conservation; and Nancy Marie Wenger, 19, of Stevens R1, state nominee for an animal science scholarship.

Deborah will receive an expense-paid trip to National 4-H Congress in Chicago, November 26 to 30, and compete for awards at the national level. Nancy's 4-H records will be entered in national competition with scholarship selections to be announced during the national conference.

Support of the conservation project is provided by John Deere, and the animal science scholarship, Allied Mills, Inc.

They were picked from among the 145,000 youth who annually take part in the Extension Service educational 4-H program.

has been a 4-H member for seven years.

A member of the Mountville 4-H Community Club, she served as president, song leader, and assisted with club activities and events as a teen leader.

The state conservation contest winner completed projects in wildlife conservation, knitting, sewing, babysitting, design with form, and teen leadership.

Locally, Deborah took part in the 4-H day camp, dress revue, queen contest, and achievement day.

She also participated in the Regional 4-H Teen Leaders Retreat, Regional 4-H Demonstration Day,

Pennsylvania 4-H Leadership Congress, and State 4-H Achievement Days.

She was chosen as the Outstanding 4-H Teen Leader in Lancaster County.

Commenting on the values of the educational youth program, Deborah said: "4-H has given me an opportunity to learn new skills. It also has given me the opportunity to learn the meaning of responsibility."

Nancy, who is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Noah Wenger, is a junior at the Delaware Valley College of Science and Agriculture, majoring in animal husbandry. She has been a 4-H member for seven years.

A member of the Lancaster County Red Rose 4-H Baby Beef and Lamb Club, she served as president, vice president, secretary, news reporter, song leader, and teen leader.

The scholarship nominee completed projects in beef, sewing, and teen leadership.

She took part in the Lancaster County 4-H Baby Beef Roundup, Lancaster County 4-H Dress Revue, Farm Show, Pennsylvania 4-H Leadership Congress, Keystone International Livestock Exposition, and Eastern National Livestock Exposition.

"With my 4-H projects, not only did I learn the many factors involved in preparing the best possible

project, but also, I became very aware of the many responsibilities which accompany any worthwhile endeavor," Nancy points out.


