York Co. Society 29

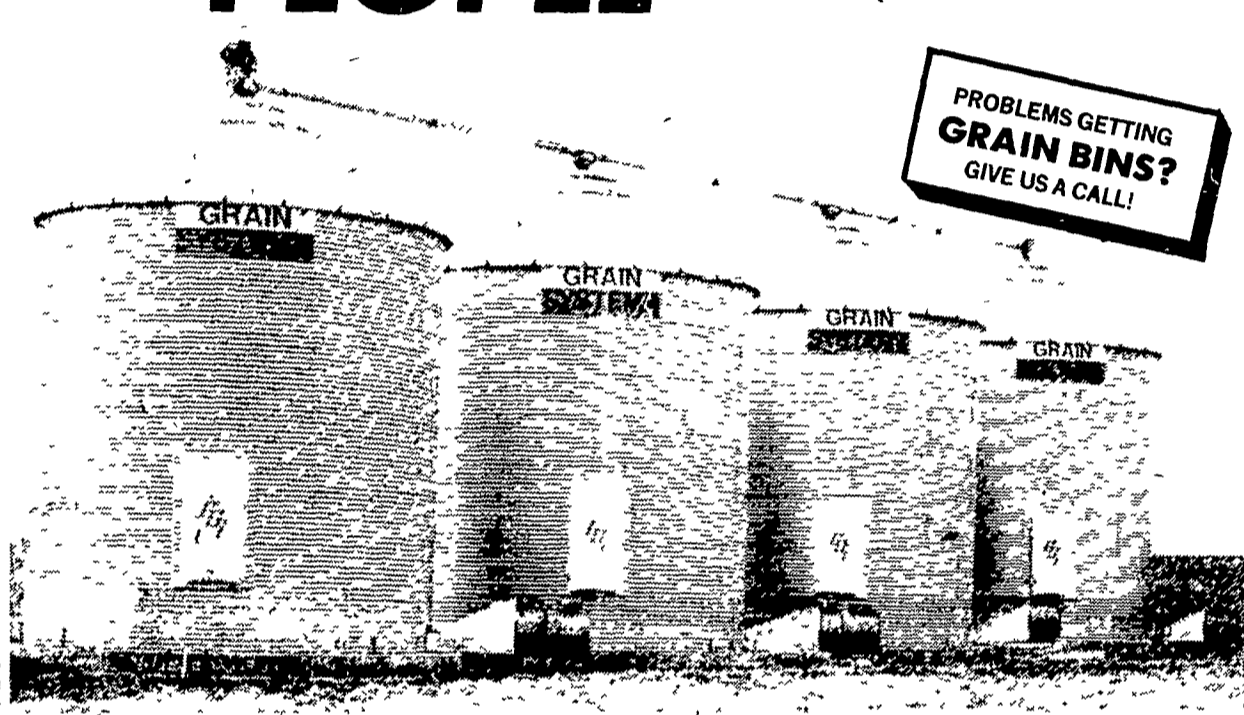
