Bought by Dutch Valley Farm, Manheim, the animal's total price was \$73.50. There were eight other sheep sold at the sale, bringing \$767.98 total sales,

and averaging 79.91 cents per pound.

The champion steer was also bought by Willie the Butcher. Shown by Barry

Geib, Manheim R4, the animal brought a price of \$1.02 per pound, a total of \$1,307.90.

Barry's brother, Earl Geib, sold the reserve champion steer, which brought 71 cents per pound. It was purchased by the Steigel Builders. The remaining eight steers sold brought a total price of \$6,106.38.

Also sold at the auction was a sheet cake, made and donated by Doris Ritter to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the farm show. It sold for \$32.50 and was bought by the Pennway Construction company of Manheim. Proceeds of the cake sale also went to the Farm Show Committee.

Auctioneer of the sale was Elmer Murry and Associates.

The Manheim Fair Association thanked all the buyers who participated in the sale for their support.




