September milk price is \$11.25

ALEXANDRIA, Va. - Market Administrator Joseph D. Shine last week announced a September 1978 base milk price of \$11.25 per hundredweight for the Middle Atlantic Marketing Order and an excess milk price of \$9.91. The weighted average September price is \$11.15 and the butterfat differential for the month is 13.3 cents. The September base milk price is up 25 cents from August and is 69 cents above the September 1977 base price. This is the second

consecutive monthly increase of 25 cents in the base price. The gross value of all producer milk was \$47.9 million. Deductions for the Advertising and Promotion Fund totaled \$299,800 in September. Order No. 4 prices are announced for 3.5 per cent milk f.o.b. plant location within 55 miles of Philadelphia and also within 75 miles from the nearer of Washington, D.C. or Baltimore. There is a 6-cent direct-delivery differential applicable to producer milk

received at plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia.

Shine reported that September producer milk receipts totaled 428.3 million pounds, a drop of 0.5 per cent from the previous month, on a daily average basis. The total number of producers reported was 7,424, an increase of 105 from August. The average daily delivery per producer was 1,923 pounds, down from 1,960 in August and below the 1,925 average of a year ago. Class I producer milk accounted for 56.59 per cent of total September producer deliveries compared to 51.37 per cent in August and 61.10 per cent last September. Base milk accounted for 93.09 per cent of total Sep-

tember production compared to 93.06 per cent the previous month and 90.83 per cent a year earlier.

Middle Atlantic Order pool handlers reported Class I in-area milk disposition of 7.1 million pounds per day during September, a seasonal increase of 11.2 per cent from August, after adjustment for variation in calendar composition.
