Rabies cases reported

HARRISBURG - Nine rabies cases, all bats, were reported in the Commonwealth during Sep-tember, according to the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Animal Industry.

One of the cases involved

human exposure when a young girl was bitten by a bat in Emmaus, Lehigh County. She has been un-dergoing rabies treatment.

One rabies case was reported in each of eight other counties: Allegheny, Blair, Butler, Bucks, Delaware, Luzerne, Northumberland and West-moreland.

So far this year 17 rabies cases have been diagnosed positive in Pennsylvania, all involving bats.
