1 cup pumpkin
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1 teaspoon baking powder
1 egg
1 cup brown sugar
2 cups flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
1/2 teaspoon salt

Frosting

1 teaspoon butter
1 tablespoon milk
1/4 cup pumpkin
2 1/4 cup confectioners' sugar
Mix sugar, lard, and egg. Add pumpkin and mix well. Sift and add dry ingredients. Bake at 350°F for 10 to 20 minutes. Mix ingredients for frosting. Frost cookies when cool.

PUMPKIN PIE
2 prepared nine inch pastry shells
2 1/4 cups brown sugar
3 teaspoons salt
5 teaspoons pumpkin spice
4 1/2 cups cooked pumpkin
4 cups milk
3 eggs

Put all ingredients in a blender and blend until smooth. Pour into pastry-lined pans. Bake at 425°F for 15 minutes. Reduce oven temperature to 350°F. Bake 45 minutes longer or until knife inserted in center comes out clean. Cool. If desired serve with sweetener whipped cream.




Auto Service Tips

Battery Performance
The approach of winter suggests that it's time to take a good look at the performance of your battery. If it has required water frequently during the summer and fall, chances are that it has become weak—and could "die" first time the temperature drops below freezing. Below freezing temperature, batteries operate at 65% efficiency; at zero degrees, at 40% efficiency.


