

Grant says Carter's inflation program fails to tackle real inflation cause

WASHINGTON, D.C. - largest general farm organization. President Carter's anti-inflation program is "good as far as it goes but fails to come to grips with the real cause of inflation - massive deficit spending by government," says Allan Grant. than the wage and price symptoms." He points out that the cost of simply conforming to government regulations now costs American business-

men in excess of \$100 billion a year.

"Relaxing these obviously inflationary pressures will be a great step toward easing the load on all Americans...businessmen, consumers and farmers alike," he adds.

As an immediate step, Grant proposes disbanding the Occupational Safety and Health Administration completely.

"OSHA is a prime example of a tremendously costly federal operation that has done little or nothing to meet the real needs of the people," Grant says. "Those millions of dollars, now being misspent on bureaucracy, should be working in the economy, and there are thousands of other excuses that must be halted to get us back on the proper economic track."

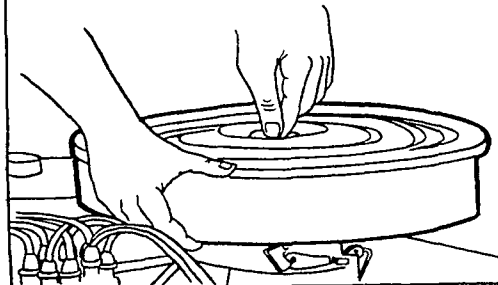

Surveys indicate 80 per cent of the time the fault lies with other problems - a plugged PCV system, leaky manifold or bad valve. Check all problem sources before dismantling carburetor.
