

## Franklin County MCMP members to vote on capital retain program

CHAMBERSBURG - A special meeting of the Franklin County members of the Maryland Cooperative Milk Producers, Inc. will be held Monday, November 6, at the Lighthouse Restaurant, Chambersburg, to consider the possibility of amending the by-laws. The meeting will begin with a 7:00 o'clock dinner.

The special membership meeting will be held in conjunction with the normal annual district membership

meeting. During the special meeting the members will consider the adoption of a proposed amendment to the by-laws. The amendment will come before the membership with the approval of the board of directors and if passed would allow for the creation of a capital per unit retain program to help finance special needs of the cooperative. After the adjournment of the special meeting the regular meeting will be convened.

The program for the regular business meeting will include reports by the Cooperative's President, Herbert Wessel; the Business Manager, Ralph Strook; Assistant Manager, Boyd Cook; District Director, M. Dice Statler; and local field representative, Jay Waybright.

The reports will relate to national and local production, sales and price trends, coordination of efforts among cooperatives to

better serve the market and milk producers, and the current status of the Holly Milk Plant. Additionally, the Cooperative's financial condition will be reviewed including its operating divisions.

The MCMP District No. 8 includes all of Franklin County and has about 50 member-producers. The representative on the MCMP Board of Directors for District No. 8 is Mr. Dice Statler, Chambersburg,
