

# Top FFA community projects selected

KANSAS CITY, Mo. - Outstanding community action efforts by chapters of the Future Farmers of America (FFA) will be recognized when the Building Our American Communities (BOAC) Awards are presented at the

1978 National FFA Convention next week. BOAC Awards will be presented to 150 of America's 8148 chapters during the Thursday morning session of the FFA's Golden Anniversary Celebration at the 1978

National Convention to be held in Kansas City, Mo. November 7-10. The BOAC program is sponsored by Lilly Endowment, Inc., Indianapolis, Ind. as a special project of the National FFA Foundation, and honors chapter efforts to make their communities better places to live and work.

Twenty-eight chapters with the most comprehensive community action programs will be presented National Gold Emblem Awards, the top award in the BOAC program. One hundred and twenty-two other FFA chapters will receive National Silver and Bronze Awards for their efforts in

community development. During the Convention one of the twenty-eight National Gold Emblem chapters will be selected to receive the National Citation for the best community improvement program in the nation.

In New Jersey, The Camdem Tech and Hunterdon Hills Chapters earned bronze emblems. Maryland chapters to be recognized were Boonesboro and Hereford, both of which will be awarded the bronze emblem. Delaware's Saddle and Grate Chapter will be presented with the gold emblem award.
