As part of the festivities Saturday night, a new Pennsylvania Lamb and Wool Queen was chosen. Ruling for the 1979 year will be Sonia Lombard, Canonsburg R1, a Washington County 18 year old miss.

The Champlian College, Vt., freshman told that she lives on a 20 acre tarm with her parents, where they raise registered Dorsets.






