volved human exposure, while a third case involved a dog, according to State Agriculture Secretary Kent Shelhamer

Shelhamer said that all four cases involved bats and were diagnosed positive by the Agriculture Department's Bureau of Animal Industry Laboratories. One case each was reported in York, Warren, Bucks and Bedford County.

In Warren County a twoyear-old girl from Sheffield was bitten while in her bedroom. A Dillsburg, York County man was also bitten by a rabid bat during the month. Both persons are receiving treatment at the present.

cinated against rabies, was bitten. The dog received a booster shot and has been confined and undergoing a ten-day observatron period by a vetermarian.

Shelhamer said that the Bedford County case emphasized his advice that pet owners have their dogs and cats vaccinated to prevent the loss of these pers through contact with rabid animals

"In the Bedford County incident, the dog will probably survive, largely due to its owner's foresight in having the pet innoculated against rabies and quick thinking in contacting a veterinarian after the exposure."
