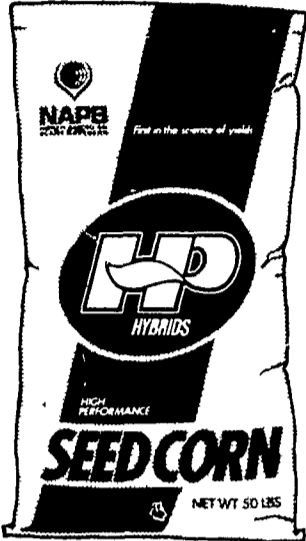

HARRISBURG, Pa. — Pennsylvanians split top honors with out-of-staters in the junior steer 4-H and FFA judging at the 22nd Annual Keystone International Livestock Exposition at the Farm Show Building in Harrisburg.

The champion steer of the junior show was exhibited by Dennis Clark of Covington, Ohio, whose crossbred steer also won the champion steer title in the heavyweight class.

The reserve champion steer honor went to Carol Krause of Slatington, Pennsylvania, whose crossbred steer was named the reserve champion in heavyweight judging.

Another member of the Krause family, Diane, won the champion steer honor in the lightweight class with her crossbred. The reserve champion steer in the lightweight class was exhibited by Jack Cripe of

Ligonier, Ind. with a crossbred.

In the middleweight class, the champion steer was exhibited by Martha Burkins of Holtwood. The reserve grand champion title went to John Grumes of Decatur, Ohio. Both were crossbreds.

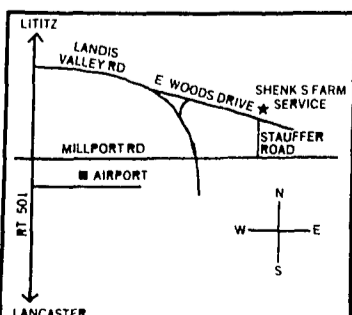
Dari-Kool Bulk-Headed Milk Tank
