stitutions have \$46 billion worth of loans outstanding across the country. That amounts to about a third of the total agricultural debt in the United States.

The Farm Credit System has gone through 60 years of changes, said Shiflet. The bonds issued by the FCS command respect among buyers, including foreign governments, insurance companies, and cor-porations. FCS bonds are considered to be a safe investment by buyers, which is a reflection of the farmer's credibility and productivity, Shiflet explained.

Serving Lancaster, Lebanon and Dauphin Counties, the Lancaster Farm Credit Service organization has nearly \$110 million worth of outstanding



loans. More than two thirds of that total are within the Federal Land Bank division, while \$42,916,687 are recorded on the Production Credit Association books.

In order to meet the growing needs of the system, a new office will be serving the Dauphin County area, beginning early next year. The facility, complete with ample parking space, will be located in Elizabethville.

In elections held during the meeting, Elvin Hess of Strasburg R1 and Jay Rohrer of Manheim R7 were chosen as directors of the Lancaster Production Credit Association. Earl Keefer of Miller, burg R1 and Jay Greider of Mount Joy R1 were given directorships in the Federal Land Bank Association of Lancaster.

Grain reserve nears billion bu.

WASHINGTON, D.C. -There were 980,326,080 bushels of feed grain and wheat in the grain reserve as of Oct. 27, according to Ray Fitzgerald, administrator of the Agricultural Stabilization and Con-servation Service (ASCS). As of that date, the reserve held 34,435,332 bushels of barley, 438,500,000 bushels of corn, 38,403,475 bushels of oats, 65,559,729 bushels of sorghum and 403,427,544 bushels of wheat.

The figures cited by administrator Fitzgerald were based on a telephone survey by ASCS.


The grain reserve takes grains off the market for a period of up to three years, or until market prices reach zgerald announced the telephone survey results, ASCS released its regular weekly price support loan activity report. The report includes figures on grains in the farmer-owned reserve and other data. The data in the weekly report lags behind the figures reported today by the administrator because of the time taken to mail the data for the weekly report to Kansas City for processing.




