Farm Credit Co-op meeting held

YORK - The Production Credit and Federal Land Bank Associations of York held their annual stockholders' meeting Thursday, November 9 at the Embers in Carlisle.

This meeting was attended by 760 member stockholders and guests.

Mr. Horace Waybright, president of the Federal Land Bank Association of York was presented with a plaque for the local association's contribution in commemoration of the Federal Land Bank of Baltimore's one billion dollar achievement in Farm Real Estate Volume.

Dougherty charted the progress of the Farm Credit System which was conceived by the Federal Government using government seed money supplemented by user capital contributions until the present. He noted that all government capital had been repaid many years ago and that this system, now the nation's largest institutional agriculture lender, is entirely owned by its stockholder users. The Farm Credit System today is entirely funded by the sale of bonds to the public investment community supplemented by locally earned capital. These bonds are not guaranteed by the federal

government and the interest earned on them is subject to federal income tax. The System nationwide has loans outstanding in excess of 120 billion dollars.

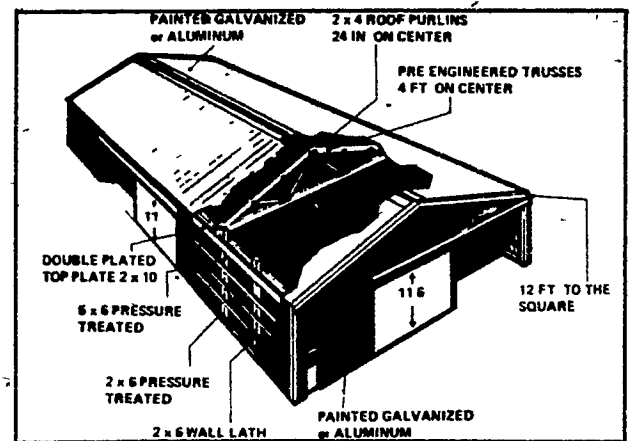

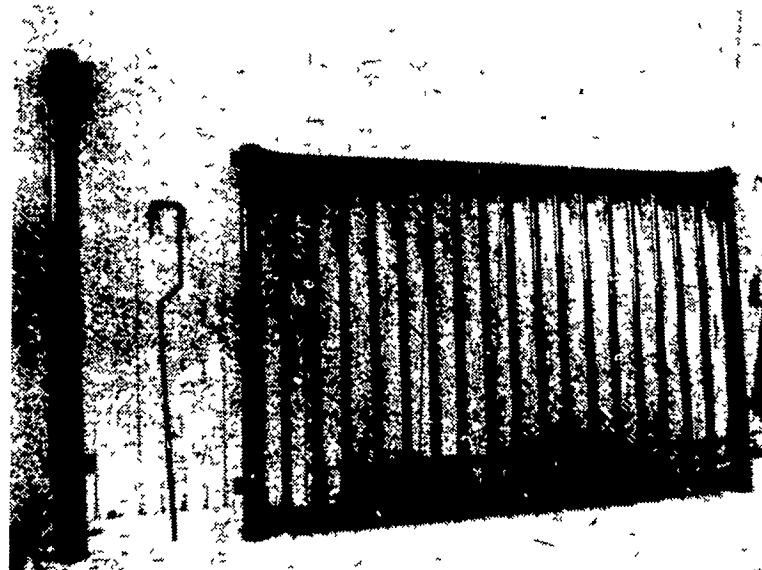

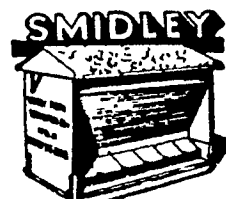
