

Eastern Pa. 4-H beef and lamb roundup held

ALLENTOWN -- The grand champion steer was exhibited by David Huff, Montgomery County, weighing 1150 pounds at the Bucks, Carbon, Lehigh, Montgomery, Northampton and Schuylkill Eastern Pennsylvania 4-H Beef and Lamb Sale, November 18, at the Allentown Fairgrounds. The buyer, Dan George, George's Foodliner, Westgate Shopping Center, Bethlehem, paid \$2.00 per pound.

Carol Krause, Lehigh County, showed the reserve grand champion steer weighing 1250 pounds which was sold for \$.96 per pound. The buyer again was Danny George of George's Foodliner.

Zettlemoyer's Auction Company, Breinigsville, R1., purchased the champion light weight steer weighing 978 pounds for \$.67 per pound. This steer was exhibited by Dianne Troxell, Schuylkill County.

The reserve champion lightweight steer weighing 901 pounds sold for \$.69 per pound and was bought by Danny George's Foodliner, Bethlehem. The steer was exhibited by Brian Ruch, Lehigh County. Alan Miller, Northampton County,

showed the reserve champion middle weight steer, weighing 1040 pounds and was purchased by Woody's Market, Weaversville for \$.68 per pound. Carol Krause, Lehigh County, showed the reserve champion heavyweight steer, weighing 1250 pounds and was purchased by Danny George's Foodliner, Bethlehem for \$.96 per pound.

The grand champion individual lamb, weighing 108 pounds was sold at \$3.50 per pound to Hess's Market Place-Butcher Shop, Terry Hentzel, Manager. It was owned by Gail Snyder, Lehigh County. The grand champion pair of lambs, exhibited by Ruth Grim, Lehigh County, was purchased by Danny George's Foodliner, Bethlehem. The Pair of Lambs weighed 216 pounds and was sold at \$1.70 per pound.

Danny George also purchased a pair of lambs, shown by Gail Snyder, Lehigh County, and weighed 108 pounds. The reserve grand champion pair of lambs, shown by Gail Snyder, Lehigh County, weighed 194 pounds and was

purchased by Gehmans, Inc., Morwood, Pa. for \$.95 per pound.

The champion heavyweight lamb was purchased by Danny George's Foodliner, for \$.90 per pound. The lamb weighed 111 pounds and was exhibited by Andy Wagner, Northampton County.

The reserve champion lightweight lamb, weighing 78 pounds was sold at \$.80 per pound to DeToni's, Schnecksville. It was owned by Kevin Reinert, Lehigh County. Reserve champion mediumweight lamb, weighing 108 pounds was sold at \$1.00 per pound to Danny George's Foodliner, Bethlehem. It was owned by Bethann Nehoda, Bucks County. Paul Drissel, Sr. purchased the reserve champion heavy weight lamb for \$.90 per pound. The lamb was exhibited by Ruth Grim, Lehigh County, weighing 125 pounds.

The sale, as was the show on Friday, was conducted by the Agricultural Extension Service, with the county agents of the six counties in charge. The auctioneer was Ralph Zettlemoyer.

Average price per pound of the steers with the grand

champion included was \$.73 per pound, without the top, the average was \$.71 per pound. Last year's averages were \$.56 and \$.54.

Average price per pound for the lambs with the grand champion included was \$1.04 per pound, without the top, the average was \$.97

per pound. Last year's averages were \$.70 and \$.67.

The total weight of the 52 steers in the sale was 56,560
