

No-till convention to show weed control concepts

UNIVERSITY PARK — New concepts in weed control, presented by a panel of three farmers and three university specialists, will be one of the features of the Mid-Atlantic No-Tillage Growers Convention to be held January 4 at the Host Farm Resort, Lancaster.

The convention, starting at 9 a.m. and ending at 3 p.m., is sponsored by the Cooperative Extension

Services of Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and West Virginia in cooperation with the agribusiness firms.

According to John H. Schwartz, Adams County Extension agent and conference chairman, tickets are available at the Extension Offices in each of the six states.

The weed control panel will consist of Wayne Harp-

ster, Huntingdon County (Pa.), Nicholas Cihlyk, Lehigh County (Pa.), and J. Thomas Kelly, Montgomery County (Md.), all farmers; Donald Daum and Dr. Willis McClellan, Penn State Extension specialists; and Dr. A. H. Kates, weed specialist at Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

Other topics during the morning session include Controlling Soil Erosion by

Dr. Jon Hall, Penn State research agronomist; and An Evaluation of Solar Grain Drying presented by Dr. Vance Morey, agricultural engineer at the University of Minnesota.

The afternoon program includes the following presentations: How to Make an Extra 20 Cents Per Bushel on Corn by H. Louis Moore, Penn State Extension agricultural

economist; Practical Methods of No-Till Forage Seedings by Melvin Brown, Centre County (Pa.) Extension agent; Fertilization and Liming Under No-Till Conditions by Dr. Wayne Hinrich, Penn State Extension agronomist; and No-Till Seeding of Small Grains by Lynn Hoffman, superintendent of the Penn

State Agronomy Research Farms.

In addition, there will be numerous educational and commercial exhibits prepared by agribusiness firms.

The annual convention attracts approximately 1,200 farmers and industry representatives, Schwartz pointed out.

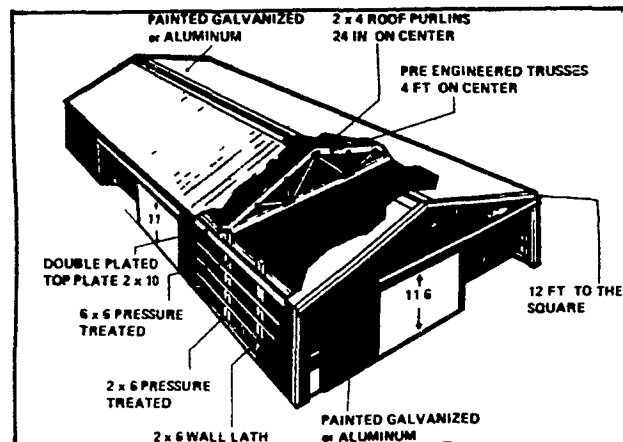

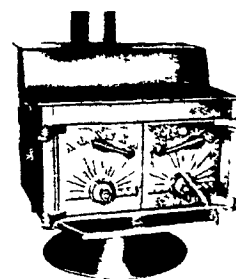
