# Insects found in firewood

Several different types of insects may enter the home in fireplace wood.

Fortunately, these insects are not likely to become established as damaging pests. However, they can become a nuisance by appearing periodically throughout the Winter months, says experts.


A person may see them first around windows and lights in rooms where firewood is stored or in a room with a fireplace. Later, the insects may wander into other areas of the house.

To prevent the appearance of these uninvited guests, one should not store firewood

FLEMINGTON, N.J. - in heated rooms for long periods of time. Enough firewood should be kept in the room to last for a few days and replensih the supply when needed.

If insects do manage to emerge from the firewood, one can control them with a household spray effective for use against flying insects.
