CCC credit

rates up

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Effective Nov. 17, interest rates for financing sales of U.S. agricultural commodities under the Commodity Credit Corporation export credit sales program were increased by one per cent.

Fred Welz, acting general sales manager for the U.S. Department of Agriculture, said the new rates for six to 36-month credit terms will be 10 1/2 per cent with a U.S. bank and 11 1/2 per cent with a foreign bank repayment guarantee.

All sale registrations received by CCC on or after Nov. 17 will be charged the new interest rates.

This action amends the interest rates announced Sept. 15.
