the fiscal year of 1978, (October 1977 to September 1978) U.S. agricultural exports now appear likely to total around \$26.6 billion, a tenth above the record value of the year 1977. The export tonnage of major bulk commodities will be up about 15 per cent, according to a report release by the USDA.

Although prices for many commodities have strengthened during the year, the export price index for fiscal year 1978 is estimated to be six per cent below 1977.

Last year, U.S. agricultural exports required the output of 107 million acres, up five million from 1976 and equivalent to 31 per cent of total U.S. harvested acreage. Food grains, chiefly wheat, accounted for 37 per cent of the export acres; oil crops acgrains, 24 per cent; cotton,
