Cattle numbers up

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Cattle and calves on feed November 1 for slaughter market in the seven States preparing monthly estimates totaled 9.30 million, 14 per cent more than a year ago and 27 per cent more than November 1, 1976, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Marketings of fed cattle during October were 187 million, a record high for the month, 17 per cent greater than last year and 25 per cent more than 1976.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the seven States during October were 2.78 million, down four per

cent from the record high set last year but 21 per cent more than October 1976. Net placements of 2.63 million were down five per cent from last year but 19 per cent greater than two years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 153 thousand compared with 115 thousand in October 1977 and 86 thousand in 1976.
