

Milk production may increase

WASHINGTON - Milk production in 1979 may total slightly above the estimated 1978 level of 122 billion pounds, and commercial use also may be slightly higher, according to a U.S. Department of Agriculture economist.

Charles N. Shaw, an agricultural economist with the department's Economics, Statistics, and

Cooperative Service, said that in early 1979, favorable milk-feed price relationships could stimulate heavier concentrate feeding and again mean sizable gains in output per cow. However, he said, pressures will remain strong for a continued decline in milk cow numbers. Milk output later in 1979 will hinge mainly on feed prices, relative increases in other production costs, and

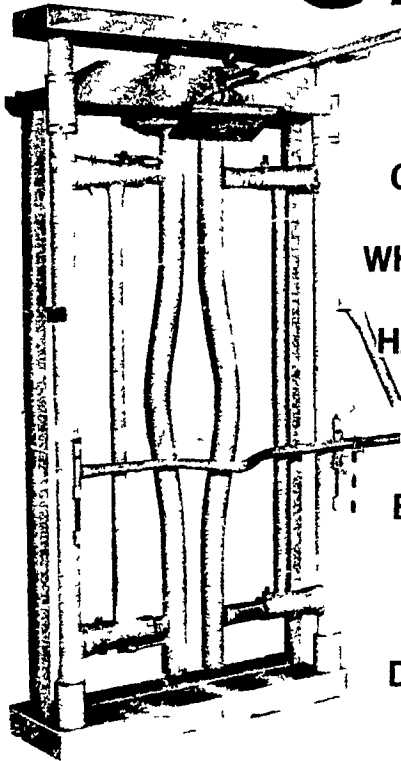
Dividend declared

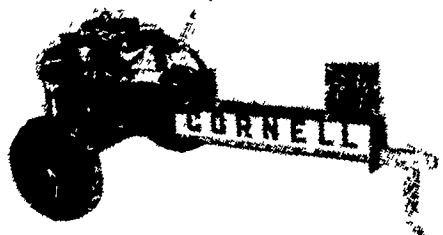

few weeks that remain before the holidays. Suggestions and Demonstration of gift wrap ideas from the unique to the very simple.

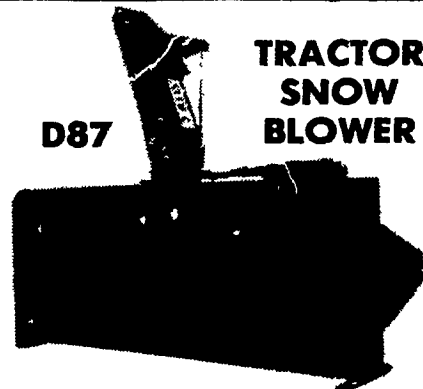
