

DHIA Monthly Report

DHIA REPORT FOR OCTOBER 1978

Cumberland County Dairy Herd Improvement records show that 6,740 cows in 117 herds were on production testing in October according to Duane G. Duncan, County Agent. Of the 94 herds on DHIA, 31 herds had an average fat production of 150 pounds per cow per day for the month. During the month 138 completed their 305 day lactation with 600 pounds of butterfat. DHIA supervisors working with the dairymen to improve efficiency include Mr. Harold Boldosser, 130 Old Gap Road, Carlisle, Mrs. Diane M. Cain, Box 277, Newville R3, and Mr. Jay Zeigler, Carlisle R1.
