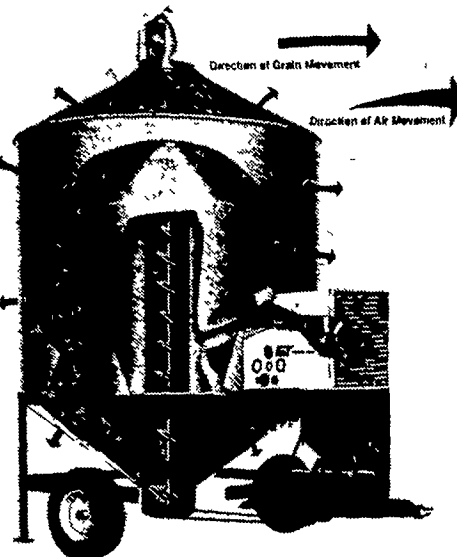

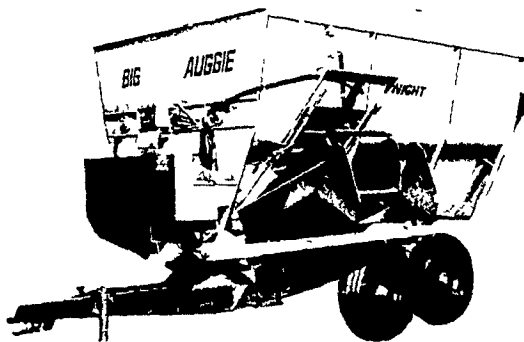

Livestock market and auction news

Omaha Cattle

December 14, 1978

CATTLE: Compared with previous week's close. Closing prices on slaughter steers were 75-1.25 higher, instances 1.50 up late and heifers closed 1.00-1.25 higher, instances 1.50 up. Cows were firm to 50 cents higher, bulls fully steady, instances 50-1.00 higher.

Four day receipts this week 17,900, last week 17,600, a year ago 18,600.

Good demand characterized the fed cattle trade during the week under review; a stronger trend prevailed each day even on a Monday run of 8000 head. Some early price stimulation was provided by purchases to fill commodity contracts, but this was not an influential factor locally on later days. Many cattle cleaned up a bit from the mud problem over the cold weekend, but feedlot conditions again worsened with the return of warmer

weather and mud problems again surfaced. Muddy cattle frequently sold 50-1.00 per cwt below clean lots of same grade. The overall finish of the steer and heifer supply was rather attractive with a fairly liberal percentage choice and a moderate volume choice and prime; also there was somewhat less price pressure on well finished consignments of mixed 3-4 yield grade. Slaughter steers made up approximately 45 pct. and heifers 33 pct. cows comprised 11 pct., feeders only 6 pct.

STEERS: At week's high time, load choice with few prime predominantly 3 1076 lbs. 56.50, load choice and prime 3-4 1251 lbs. 56.25, load same grade 1165 lbs. carrying moderate amount of mud 56.00. Choice 2-4 relatively clean 1000-1325 lbs. 55.00-56.00, some mostly choice carrying heavy coating of mud 54.50-54.75 at midweek. Mixed good and choice 2-3 1000-1250 lbs. 54.00-55.50 late. Good 2-3 50.00-

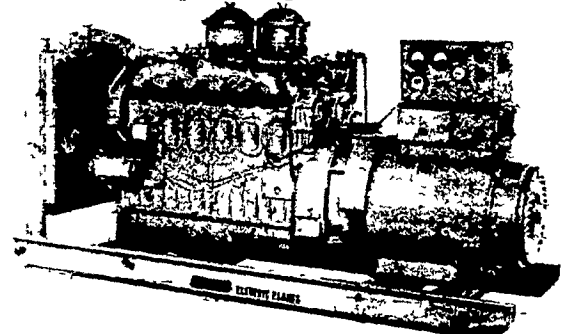
