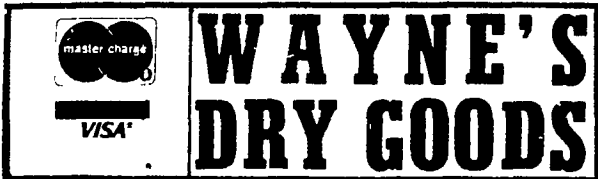

HERSHEY - The program of the Keystone Pork Congress has been announced, with Earl Butz being the keynote banquet speaker, along with the National Pork Queen Tammy Moerer, at the February 16 event. The Congress will be held at the Hershey Motor Lodge, Hershey, and is sponsored by the Pennsylvania Pork Council.

The Congress will open at 8 a.m. Starting at 10 a.m. there will be two different sessions. Session A will be on producing feeder pigs. This session will include subjects on breeding herd housing by Robert Fritschen, breeding

herd management by Dan Hagen, and a discussion led by the two after their speeches.

Session B, titled buying and selling feeder pigs will include feeding, growing and finishing pigs, presented by Grant Sherritt, and controlling health problems in newly purchased feeder pigs, by L. Hutchinson. A discussion will follow.

From 12-1:30 p.m. there will be a break for lunch. The general session will begin at 1:30 p.m. with housing the growing and finishing pig, presented by Fritschen.

At 3:45 both Sessions A and B will regroup for discussions on flat decks and other weaned facilities, by Fritschen, and the outlook for feeding pigs, presented by H.L. Moore.

The sessions will conclude at 5:15. The banquet will begin at 6:30 p.m. with Earl Butz as the main speaker.

The Porkette's will also have their own program. At 10 a.m. there will be an

election of officers and committees. Gail McPherson will speak at 10:30 a.m. Her speech is on defending your product. Following lunch, at 1:30 p.m., the Porkettes will see a fashion show.

A porcine heart valve seminar, presented by Dr. William Pierce and Dr. R.K. Balsara, will begin at 2:45 p.m. A craft demonstration will conclude the Porkette's program at 4 p.m.

In addition to the speeches and discussions, a separate room will be set up with a computer terminal for persons interested in the various computer programs available in swine production. Virgil Crowley will be in charge of the computers.

Also, in same room, Lester Burdette will be demonstrating the programs available in the hand held programmable calculator.

There will be 60 commercial exhibits and displays related to all segments of the swine industry.

Deadline for banquet tickets is February 2, 1979.
