Tops in butterfat production was "Arlene," owned by Isaac Zimmerman. She produced 21,702 pounds of milk, had a 4.8 per cent test, and had 1031 pounds of butterfat.

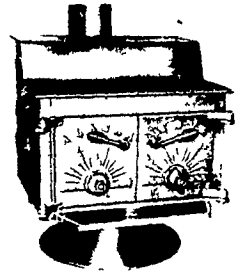

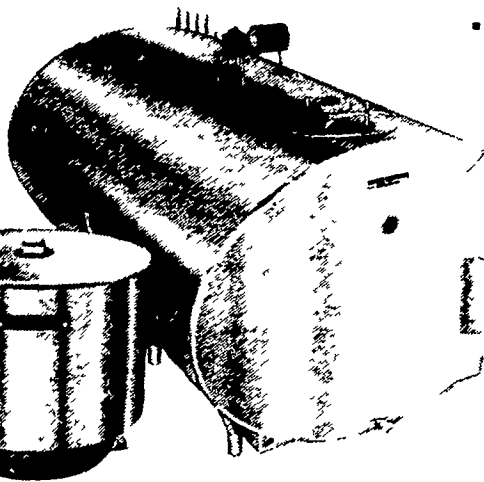
