

Pa. milk production down

HARRISBURG - Milk production in Pennsylvania during November 1978 totaled 623 million pounds, down five per cent from the previous month but one per cent above a year earlier according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The number of milk cows in the commonwealth during November was 700,000 head, down 3,000 head from a year ago. Production per cow averaged 890 pounds in

November, up approximately one per cent from a year ago.

Milk production in the United States during November totaled 9.4 billion pounds, down fractionally from November 1977. Production per cow averaged 869 pounds, up almost one per cent from a year ago. Milk cows on farms totaled 10.8 million head, down one per cent from last year.



4-H photographer cited

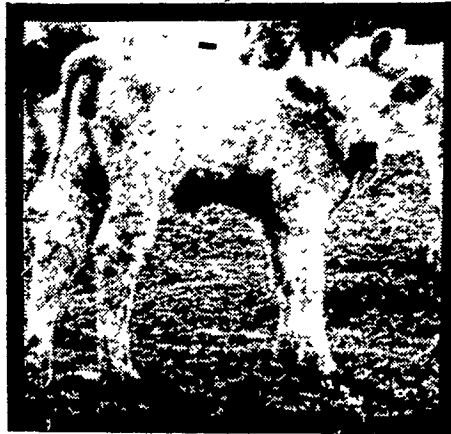
NEW HOLLAND - A New Holland photographer is one of four Pennsylvanians chosen to represent the state in the fifth National 4-H Photo Exhibit.


Tu Hoang Vu, New Holland, will have a photograph of a stabled horse as part of the show. He also had entered



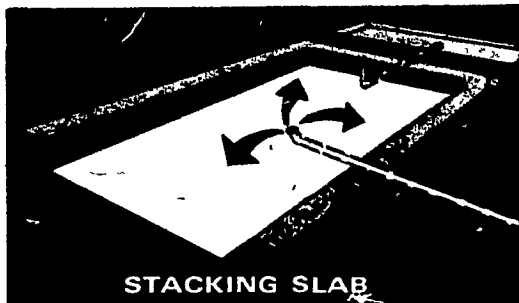
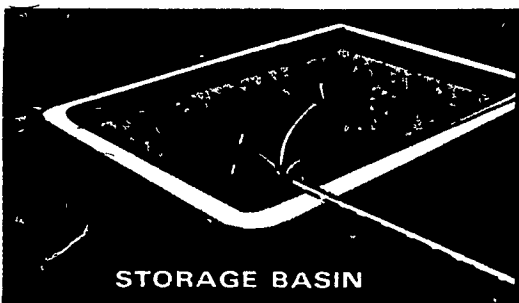
