Craig is presently employed by the Weis Food Market while he is con-

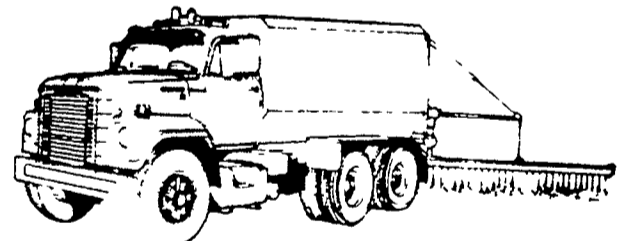

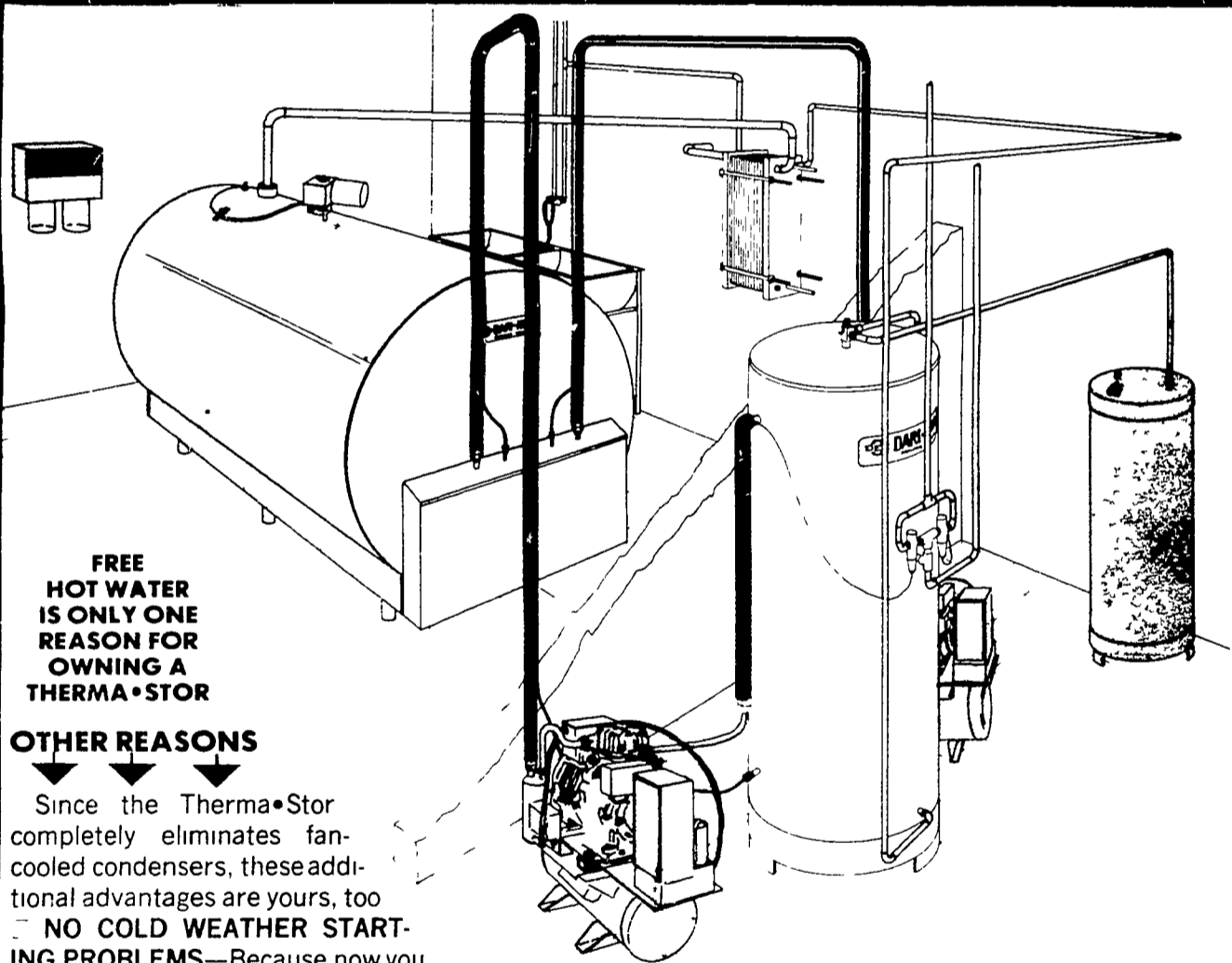

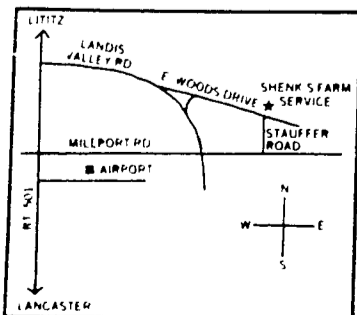
