female, "RF Miss ADV Evan 84T," a Spring heifer calf, was exhibited by Earl Renner, Waynesboro R3, Greene County.

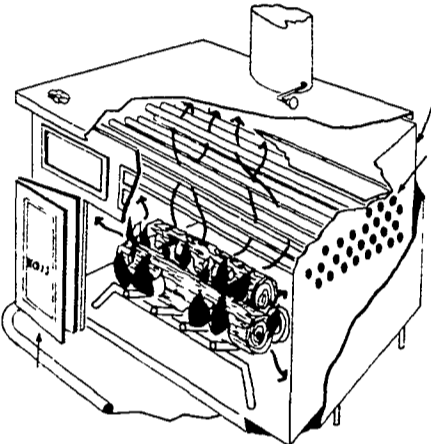
Kimberly Brown, Abbottstown R1, captured the grand championship in Hereford bull judging

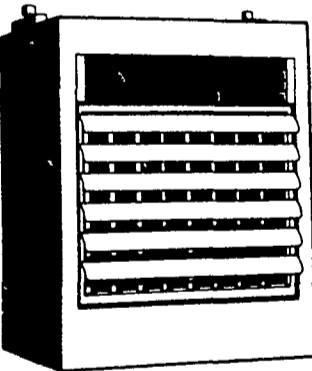

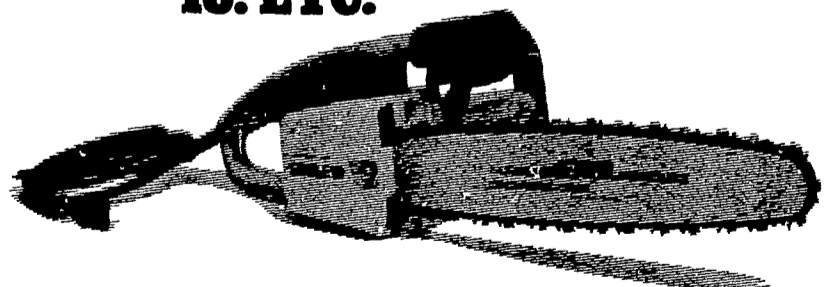
