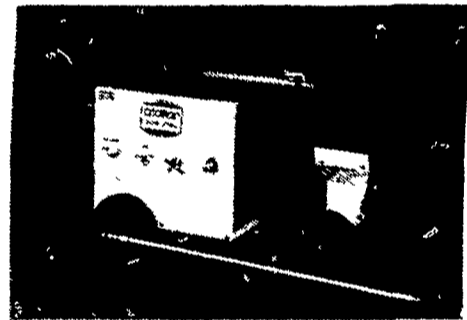
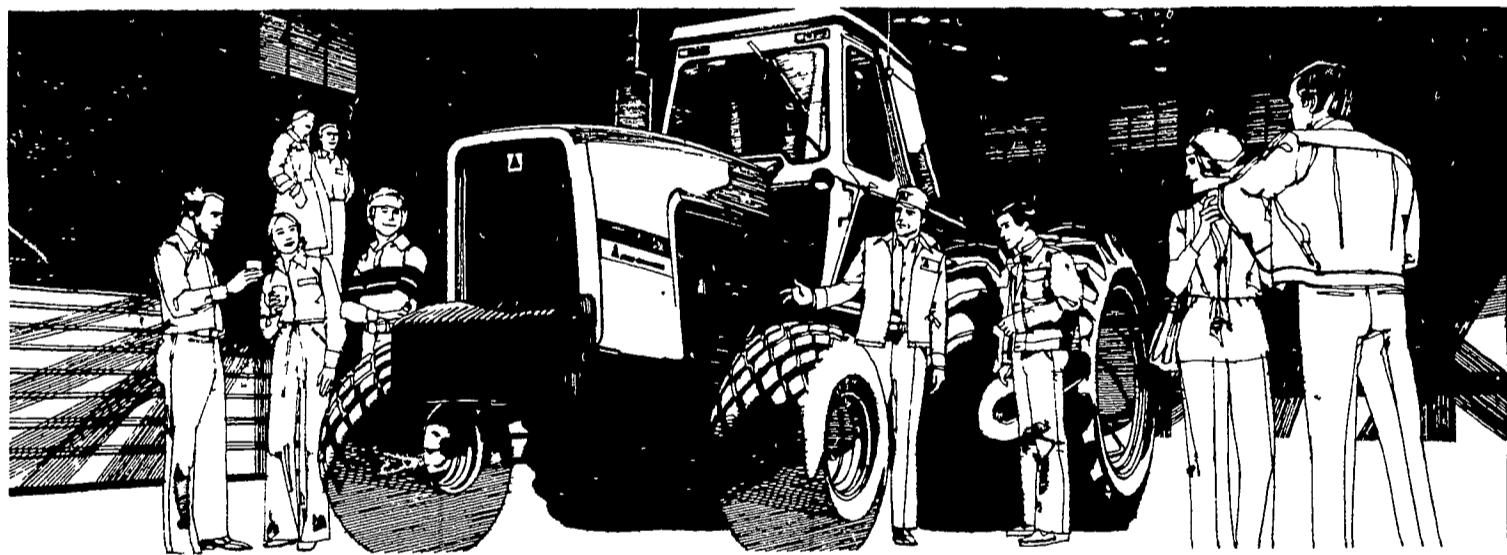


Fire destroys barn at the Marlin Cassel farm



Tragedy struck the Marlin Cassel Farm, Manheim R1, the morning of Wednesday, January 24. While waiting with her children at the school bus stop, Mrs. Cassel noticed flames in their frame barn. Nine fire companies responded to the Cassel's call. Fortunately only one or two heifers were lost in the fire. Fifty cows, some heifers and steers were able to escape the flames. A large tobacco shed 20 feet away, a small corn barn, and 400 pigs housed near by, escaped the

injury and destruction of the fire. According to Mrs. Cassel, there were between 8 and 9000 bales of hay in the barn along with a large amount of shelled corn. Relay systems were set up to refill the tanks with water at a water main about a mile away. The Manheim fire company reported the fire was fought for three hours. They remained on the scene until 4:30 p.m. A flare up was reported in the smoldering hay, early the next morning.

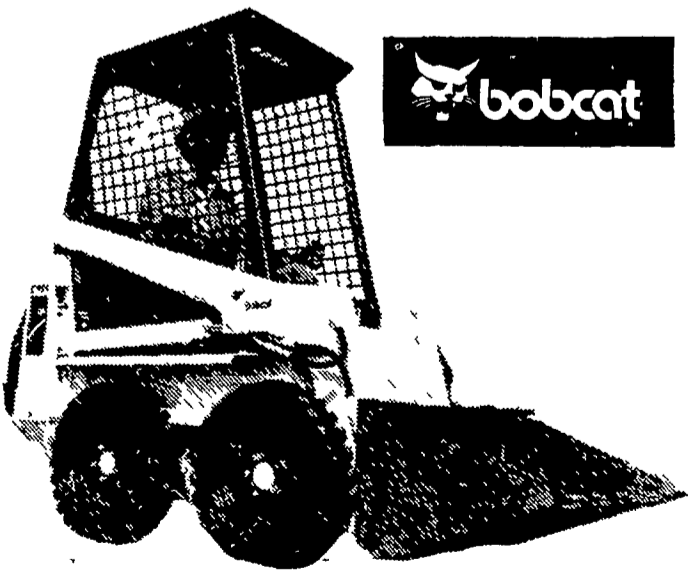
