Soybean acreage expected to jump

HARRISBURG - Pennsylvania farmers intend to plant increased acreages of corn, oats and especially soybeans on January 1, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service. Soybean acreage in the state is expected at 85,000 acres, an increase of 31 per cent from 1978.

Other acreage planting intentions and per cent changes from 1978 are: oats, `70,000 acres, up three per cent; corn, 1,630,000 acres, up one per cent; and barley, 135,000 acres, no change

from 1978. Sorghum acreage is also estimated for 1979 at 18,000 acres.

National figures from 34 states surveyed in January are as follows: corn, 79.2 million acres, up one per cent; soybeans, 65.4 million acres, up four per cent; oats, 15.2 million acres, down four per cent; sorghum, 15.2 million acres, down six per cent; and barley, 8.82 million acres, down eight per cent.
