WASHINGTON, D.C. - The Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) has approved two loan guarantees to finance pilot projects that will convert agricultural and forestry products into fuel and other energy sources. This makes a total of three projects contingently approved by CCC.

Current legislation provides for loan guarantees of up to \$15 million for a maximum of four pilot energy projects, said Weldon Barton, director of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Office of Energy. The projects approved Jan.
