Pea and lima growers to meet

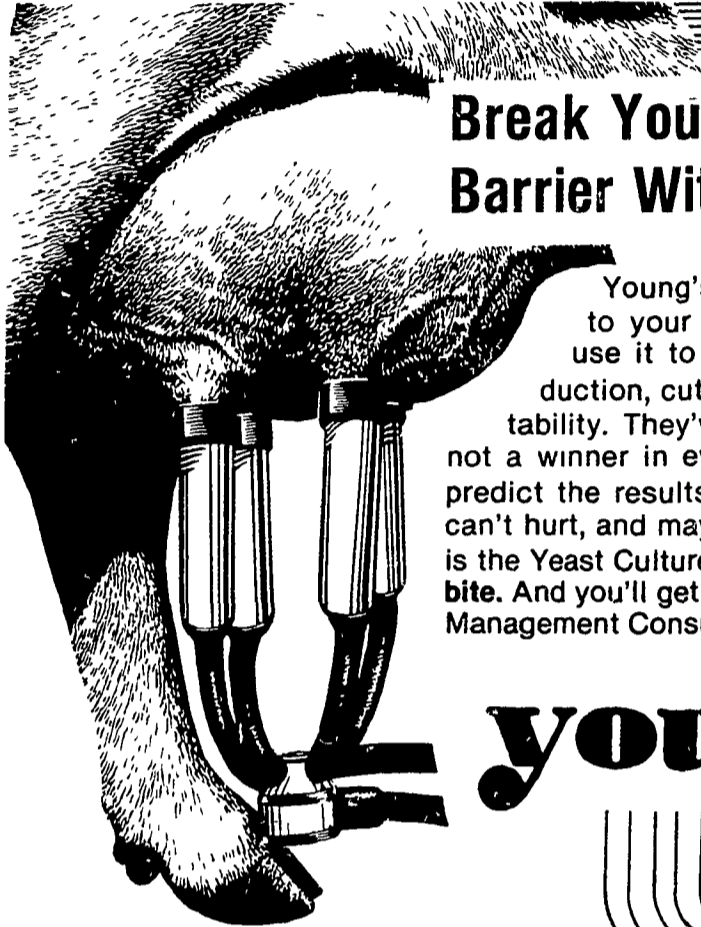
NEWARK, Del. - There will be a meeting of the Delaware pea and lima bean growers, on Tuesday afternoon, February 6, at the University of Delaware's Georgetown Substation. The meeting, which is sponsored by pea and lima growers on the peninsula plus the Maryland and Delaware cooperative Extension services, will start at 1 p.m. and run until 4 p.m.

According to Extension

vegetable specialist Dr. Michael Orzolek, the program will include a report on the performance of new varieties, a review of fertility and spacing research with limas, a review of the Maryland/Delaware nematode survey, a presentation on the direction the USDA lima bean breeding program is taking, and a discussion of the problem of blemished beans.
