In addition to their stay in State Game Lands near Hill Creek State Park, the 14 Junior Ag. Club members were also taken on a tour of

wildlife food and habitat plots by Tioga-Potter Counties Game Lands Manager Dave Brown. He is an employee of the Pennsylvania Game Commission.

Before returning home, the group also visited the Pennsylvania Grand Canyon, the Monis Fish Hatchery, the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum, the Denton Hill Ski Area, saw a Winter memory program, and attended church ser-

vices at Draper. In addition, the youngsters also had an opportunity to use snowshoes, observe ice fishing, and visit a beaver house where they learned how leavers eat and live.

Accompanying the group were Charles Ackley, advisor and vocational agriculture instructor; Jack Shrimplin, student teacher; and Leonard Martin, father of one of the boys.

Club leaders are Glenn Aument, Charles Craig,

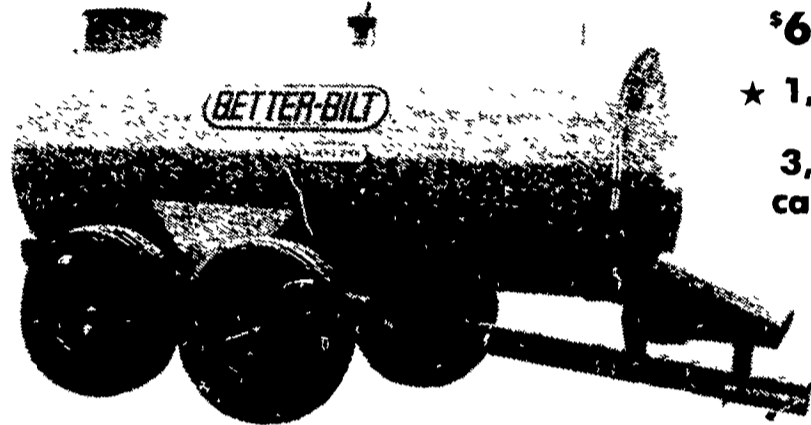
Gordon Herr, Paul Trimble, and Ben Wenger.

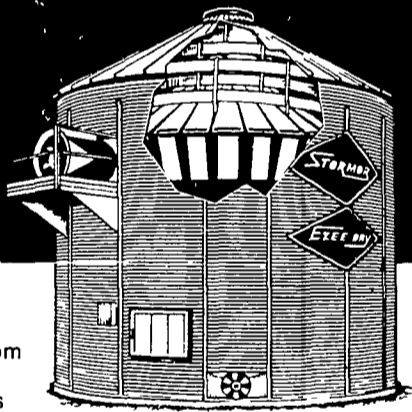

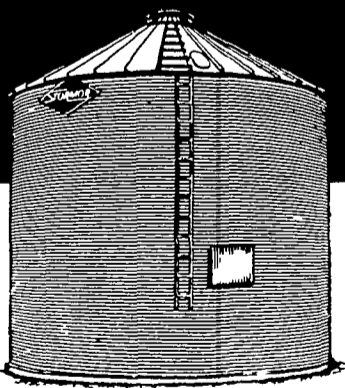

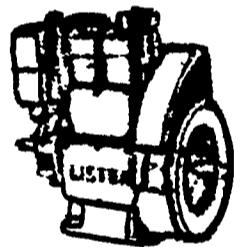
