NEW YORK, N.Y. - Fruit and vegetable growers, dealers, wholesalers and retailers can now obtain up-to-date market news information from the Hunts Point Terminal Market in New York City as well as data from shipping points in major produce growing areas by calling 212-542-3564.

According to Michael E. Pflueger, officer-in-charge of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's fruit and vegetable market news office at Hunts Point, the recorded messages, which run about two minutes, are up-dated twice each weekday.

Shipping point information can be heard between 6:30 a.m. and noon, while trading data on the Hunts Point market is available from noon until 6:30 a.m. the following weekday. The latter report includes prices as well as trends on major produce items.

The market news program is operated by the department's Agricultural Marketing Service, usually in cooperation with state departments of agriculture. It provides accurate, up-to-the-minute information on the supply, demand, prices and movement of major agricultural products.

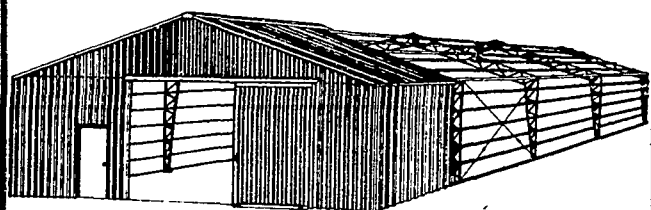
Some of the Societies will

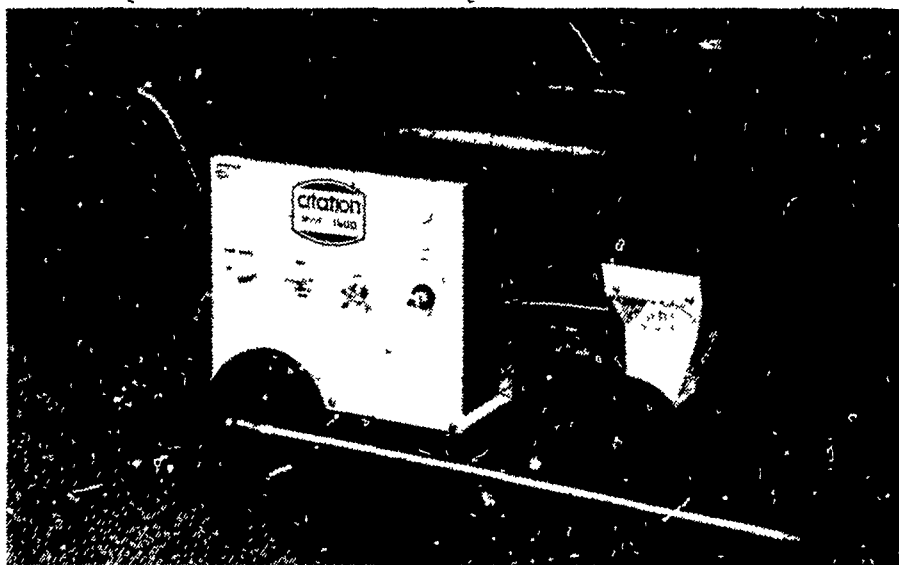

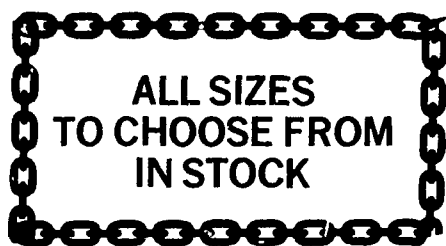

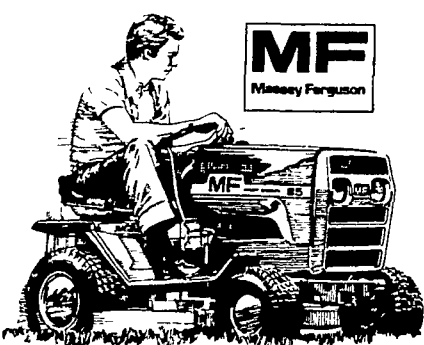
