



Chester County DHIA Monthly Report

DECEMBER 1978

Tammy, a 7-year old Holstein herd in the George Lamborn herd, and S Belring, a 4-year old Ayrshire at Ardrossan Farms, shared top honors for high production in the latest Chester County DHIA report. The Ayrshire outmilked all other cows on official test by pumping out 30,004 pounds of milk with a 3.6 per cent test and 1077 pounds of butterfat. Pammy won the butterfat crown with her lactation of 23,955 pounds of milk, a 5.2 per cent test, and 1249 pounds of butterfat.
