Guest speaker for the evening was Mike Ondik, deer herd manager and self-styled naturalist from Penn State University.

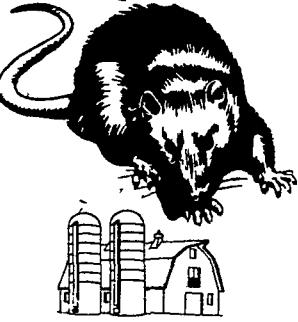
"We need to take better care of our land, including farmland," Ondik emphasized early in his

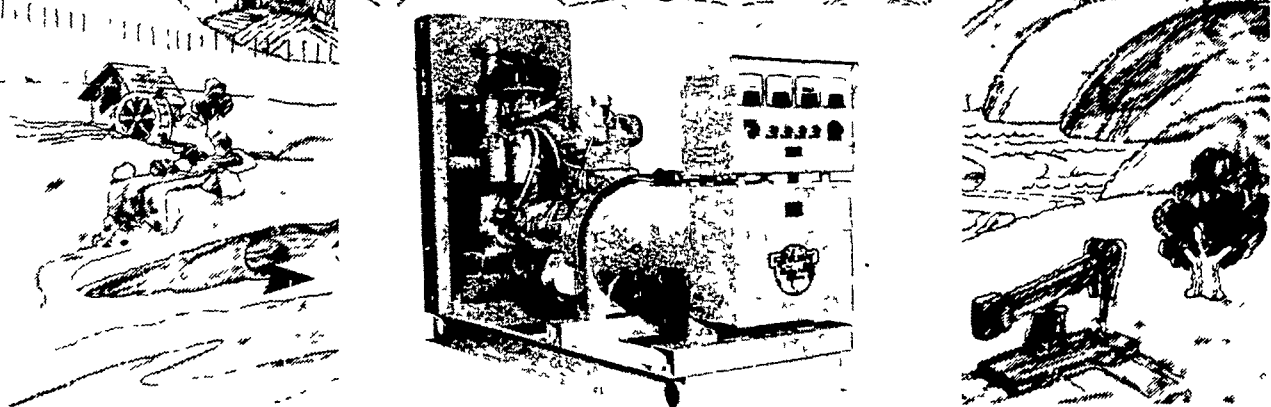

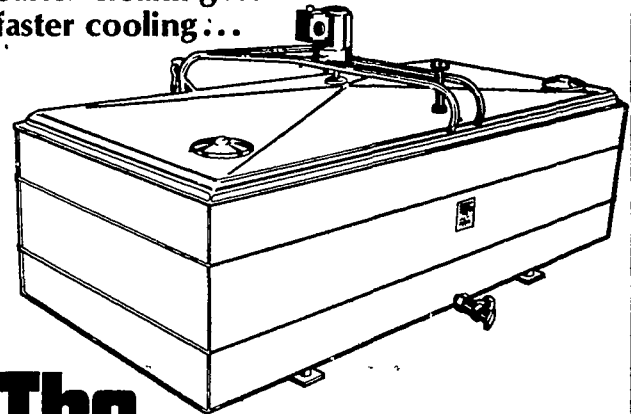
