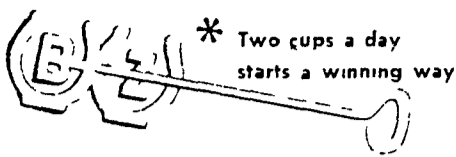

Federal tax strategy book offered

CHURCHVILLE -- California's 'Proposition 13' is only the tip of the iceberg, according to a new book which predicts the same thing happening in Pennsylvania. "Taxpayer on Strike" is written out of the experiences of authors Robert Graham and Robert Culp, who gathered more than 200,000 signatures

during Summer 1978 in support of a petition to place a similar tax limitation (Proposition 12) on the Pennsylvania ballot. This proposition, with 46 co-sponsors, is now under consideration in the Commonwealth House of Representatives as HR 2767. "Taxpayer on Strike" sets

forth a strategy first to control, then to reduce Pennsylvania taxes. The presentation is intended to serve as a model for similar programs in other states, according to the authors. Pa. taxpayers have high Federal tax

HARRISBURG - Pennsylvania taxpayers will be required to pay approximately \$28.4 billion in Federal taxes as their share of the cost of the Federal spending budget of \$531.6 billion proposed by President Carter for the 1980 Federal fiscal year beginning October 1, 1979, according to an estimate by the Pennsylvania Chamber of Commerce.

This estimate was based on the State Chamber's calculations that Pennsylvania's taxpayers bear 5.34 per cent of all Federal taxes.

In 1969, just ten years ago, President Johnson, before turning over the reins to the Nixon Administration, proposed a budget totaling \$195 billion, and Penn-

sylvania's share was estimated at \$11.9 billion.

The State Chamber pointed out that any change which Congress may make in this budget will reduce or increase the amount that Pennsylvania taxpayers will have to bear, depending on whether Congress cuts or spends more.

The \$28.4 billion share, which would be borne by Pennsylvania taxpayers to support the President's proposed budget, is over \$12 billion more than the amount of wages and salaries paid to Pennsylvania employees of manufacturing industries in 1977.

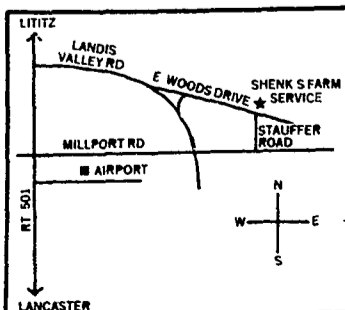

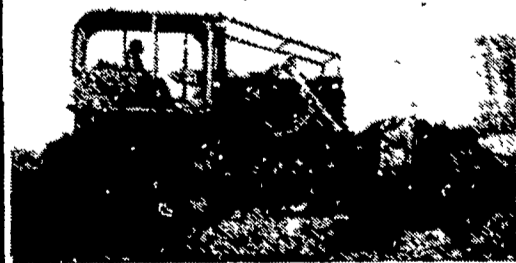
