

Federal taxes as their share of the cost of the Federal billion proposed by President Carter for the 1980 Federal fiscal year begin-ning October 1. 1979, according to an estimate by the Pennsylvania Chamber of Commerce.

This estimate was based on the State Chamber's calculations that Pennsvlvania's taxpayers bear 5.34 per cent of all Federal taxes.

The \$28.4 billion share, which would be borne by Pennsylvania taxpayers to support the President's proposed budget, is over \$12 billion more than the amount of wages and salaries paid to Pennsylvania employees of manufacturing industries in 1977.
