

# Chop more silage without planting more corn.

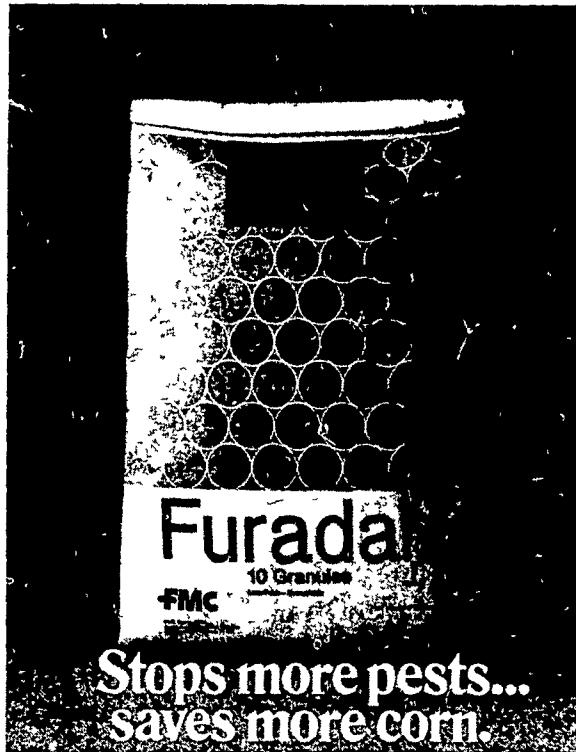
