Bulls firm. Slaughter steers and heifers reached an all time high for Peoria during this session. Receipts about 65 percent

slaughter steers, 30 percent slaughter heifers, balance mainly cows.

Compared to last weeks close, slaughter steers 1.00 to mostly 1.50 higher. Slaughter heifers mostly 1.50, instances 2.00 higher. Cows firm to mostly .50 higher. Bulls fully 1.00 higher. Slaughter supply mainly choice and mixed choice and prime 2-4 1025-1200 lb. steers, around 35 heifers and 15 per cent cows.

Advances during the past week boosted prices for all represented slaughter classes to all time record highs.

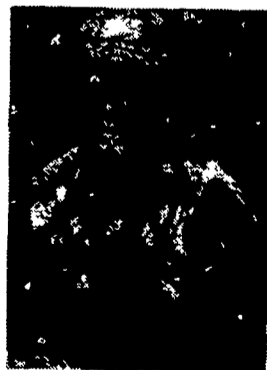
