Moderately active, feeder cattle and calves mostly steady, some sales weak to 1.00 lower on Good and mixed Good and Choice offerings under 500 lbs; majority. Receipts Choice

and mixed Good and Choice 300-800 lbs. feeder steers and 300-700 lbs. feeder heifer including some early arrivals from wheat pastures; large attendance of buyers.

**FOR THE WEEK:**  
Compared to late last week, feeder cattle and calves mostly 3.00-5.00 higher in a very good demand; slaughter cows 1.00-2.00 higher late sales Utility and Commercial 2-3 50.75-54.75 with high dressing holstein cows from 56.00-57.25; cutter cows 1-3 largely 46.75-49.00; slaughter bulls steady to 1.00 higher. YG 1-2 1000-2000 lbs. 62.75-69.00. Salable receipts near 14,700 head compared to 7160 last week and 14,563 the comparable period a year ago. Cows and bulls comprised 9 percent of the salable receipts with feeder cattle and calves making up 91 percent of the total.

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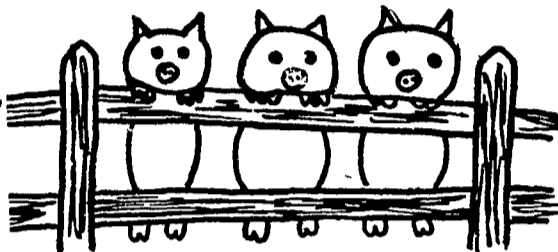
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
