

# Cloister FFA wins meat judging contest

EPHRATA — Three sophomores from the Cloister FFA Chapter comprised the winning

Lancaster County FFA meat judging team during recent competition at the Kunzler's and Co. Inc., Lancaster.

Seven FFA chapters from the County were represented. Members of the winning team included Marvin Fox, son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Fox, Lititz R1; Marvin Horst, son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Horst, Ephrata; and Larry Horst, son of Mr. and Mrs. Luke Horst, Stevens R1.

Marvin Fox was also the top individual judge from approximately 30 individuals competing.

In competition from the Cloister FFA on an individual basis were Marvin Weiler, son of Mr. and Mrs. Eli Weiler, Stevens R1. Marvin placed second. Also, Avery Copenhaver, son of

Mr. and Mrs. Perry Copenhaver of Akron. Avery placed fourth. Scott Augsburger, son of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Augsburger, Reinholds R1, was the seventh high individual.

"It was a challenge" said first place winner, Marvin Fox. "The class of beef ribs was the hardest to place because they all looked alike."

The contest consisted of identifying 25 retail meat cuts, placing a class of hams, beef ribs, and yield and quality grading five beef carcasses.

The second place team was from Lampeter-Strasburg and the third

place team was from the Manor FFA Chapter.

The winning team received a traveling trophy which they won in 1976, 1978, and now in 1979. The Trophy must be won three years in a row to find it's permanent home in a chapters trophy

case. Lancaster Stockyards, Inc. are the trophy's sponsor. Gere Gregg and other Kunzler personnel prepared the contest.

The winning team's coach was J. Carl Graybill, Ephrata High School agriculture instructor.

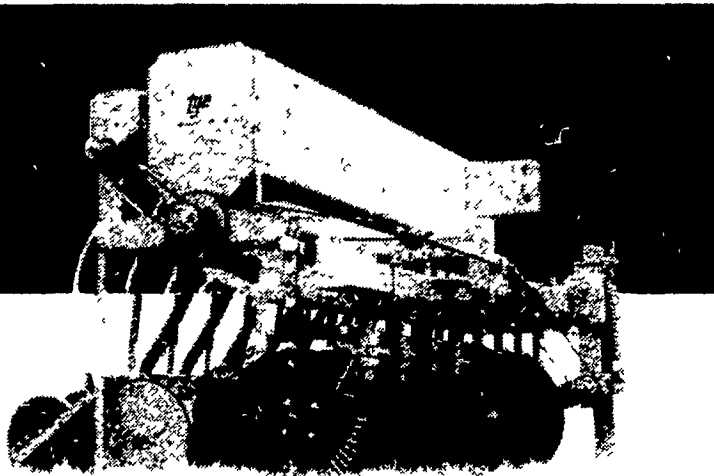
