

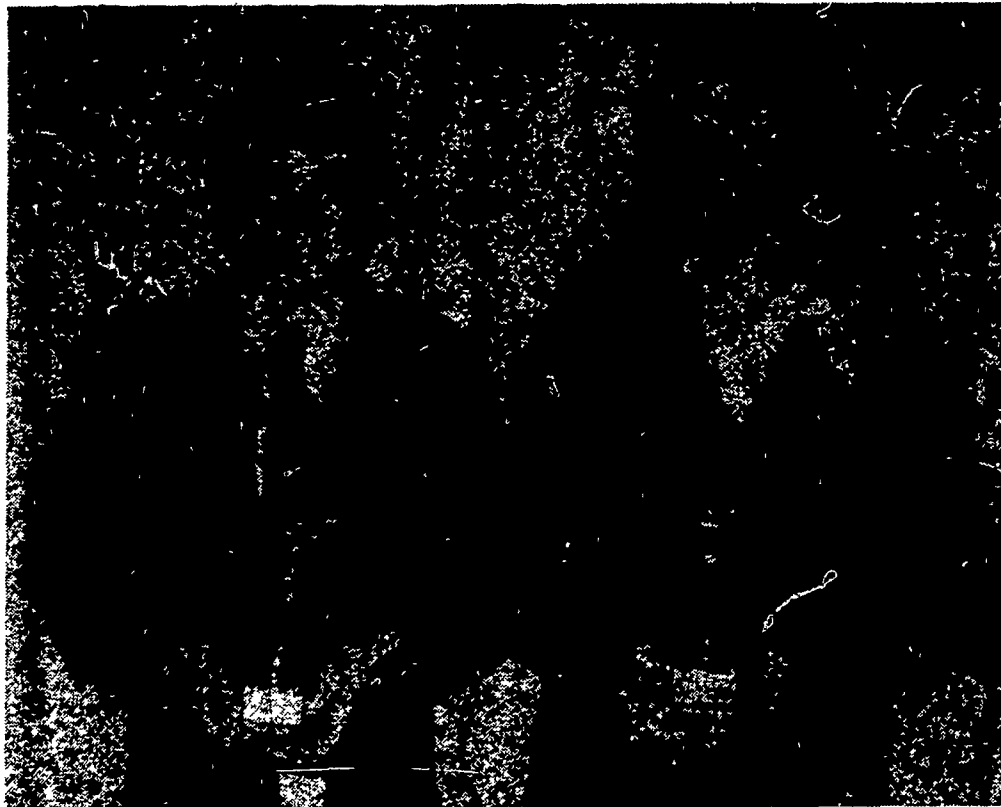
# Grassland environmental FFA honors members


