## Ironing safety tips given

**MEDIA** - More than 6000 people were injured last year in ironing accidents. Small children are especially vulnerable because they trip over or pull cords, causing hot irons to fall on them. Greta C. Vairo, Extension Home Economist with the Penn State Extension Service says you can avoid accidents with irons by following these safety guidelines:

Choose an iron with a wide resting base so it can't tip easily.

Always unplug the iron and place it out of children's reach even if you leave for just a few minutes.

Use a sturdy ironing board, placing the board as close as possible to a wall and the outlet in which the iron is plugged.

Unplug a steam iron when you fill it. If water spills on live electrical components, it could cause shock.

Have a leaking iron repaired. The water could cause scalding or a fatal electrical shock.

Coil the cord when you've finished ironing. Then place the iron high up to cool, far out of children's reach.
