The exhibit is sponsored by the Keystone Milk Marketing Council, Inc.

The tour begins in Easton on May 17 and continues in Sharon, Altoona, Reading, York, Harrisburg, Scranton, Quakertown and Exton before closing in Lancaster as part of the annual Farm-City Week in mid-October.
