

Seed violation cleared

NEW YORK, N.Y. — DeWine and Rainma Seed Co., Inc., Yellow Springs,

Ohio, has paid \$875 to settle a case involving alleged violations of the Federal Seed Act. The act, administered by U.S. Department of Agriculture officials, is a truth-in-labeling law designed to protect farmers and consumers who buy seed.

The case involved three shipments of rye, redtop and timothy seed to Indiana, Pennsylvania and Virginia in 1974 and 1976.

Alleged violations, while not the same for all shipments, were false labeling as to the percentage of germination, failure to label the presence of noxious-weed seeds and failure to keep required records.

Seed regulatory officials in Indiana, Pennsylvania and Virginia cooperated with officials of AMS in carrying out the investigation.
