of the show again, it will again be presented. All correspondence should be addressed to Evening Magazine Channel 13, TV Hill Baltimore, Maryland 21211

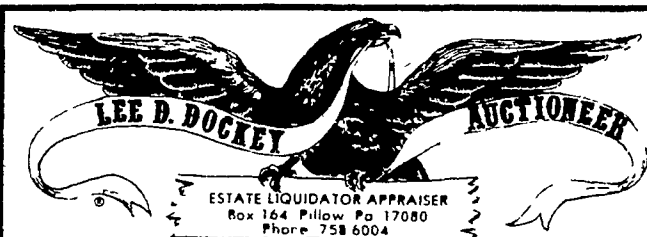
