The top two teams in the contest will represent the area in the state FFA contest at the Pennsylvania State University this June.



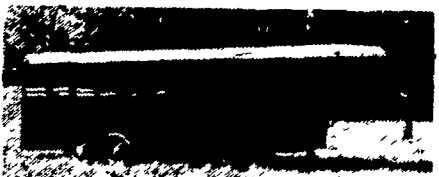

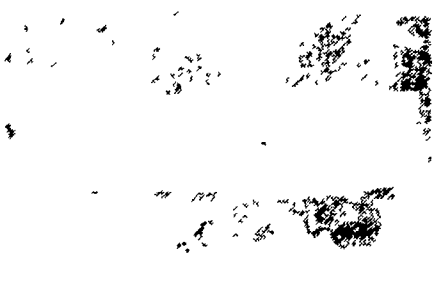

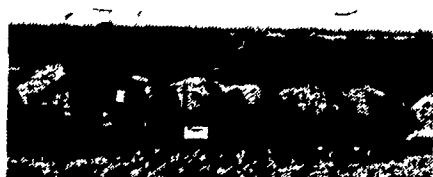
Standard Metal Top Stock Trailer As Shown Above Comes In Lengths Of 14 & 16 Feet



Standard Livestock Trailer 20' x 6' Trailer Has The 2 Ft Escape Door



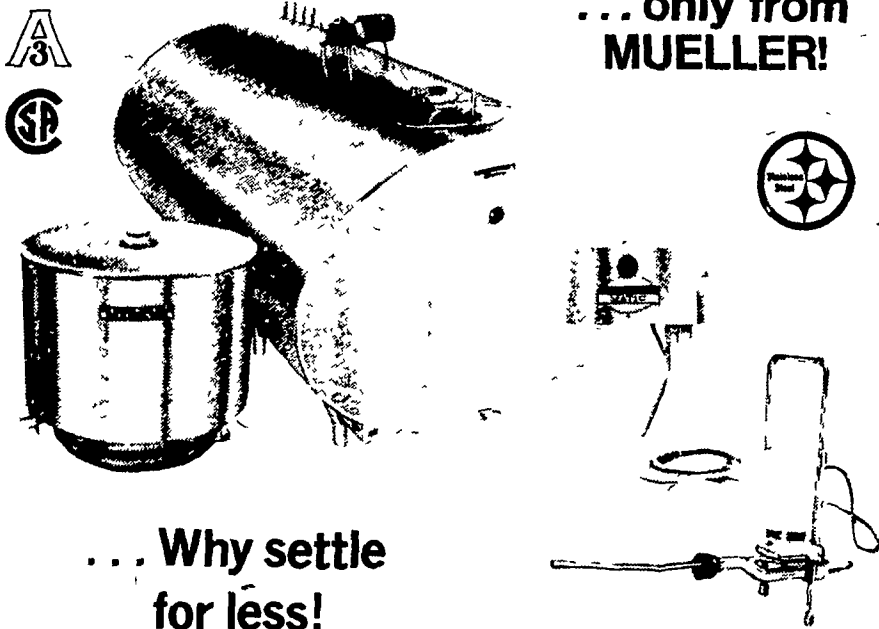
