

all evidence of motion, sight or sound has stopped."

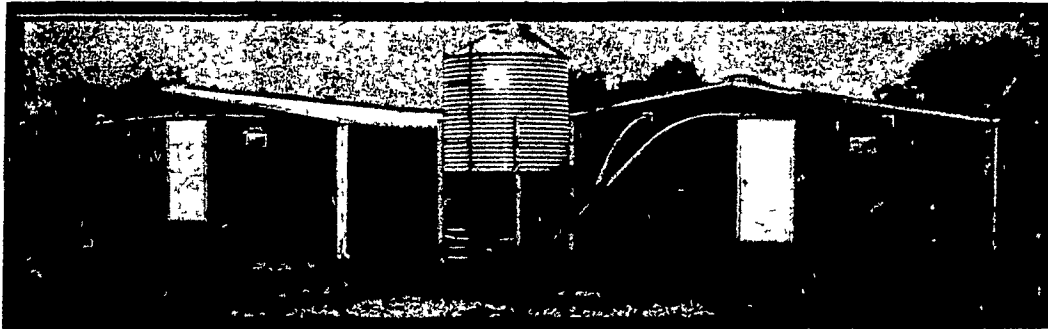
Other reminders deal with studying the owner's manual, keeping children away from machinery and a continuing safety consciousness.

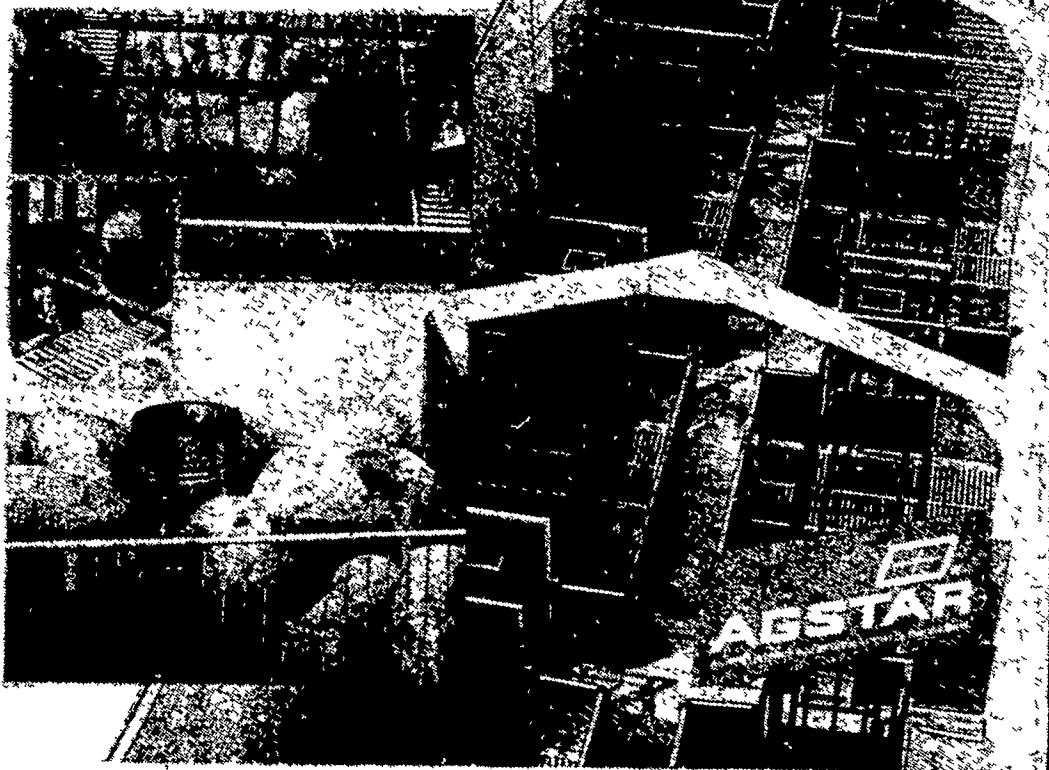
