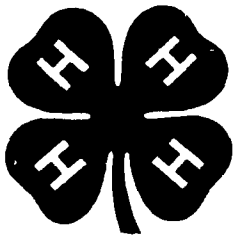

## New York livestock operators suspended

BULLVILLE, N.Y. - John E. Tyrrell, Jr., and Maude B. Tyrrell, former operators of the John Tyrrell and Sons stockyard in Bullville, N.Y., have been suspended as registrants under the Packers and Stockyards (P&S) Act for violating financial requirements.

U.S. Department of Agriculture officials said the Tyrrells drew livestock trade from southeastern New York. They are not operating at this time.

The Tyrrells consented to the order and waived oral hearing, without admitting or denying the charges.

Administrative Law Judge John G. Lebet suspended the Tyrrell's registration for 30 days starting May 6, and until they demonstrate that they are longer insolvent. The Tyrrells may not operate as a dealer or market agency during the suspension.

The Tyrrells also were ordered to cease and desist from issuing insufficient funds checks in payment of net proceeds to consignors and failing to pay net

proceeds to consignors, when due.

Dealers and market agencies are required under the P & S Act to maintain a solvent financial position and market agencies are

required to pay net proceeds to livestock consignors promptly.

The P&S Act is a fair practices law administered by the packers and stockyards program of USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service. It promotes and maintains fair and open competition in the marketing of livestock, poultry and meat.

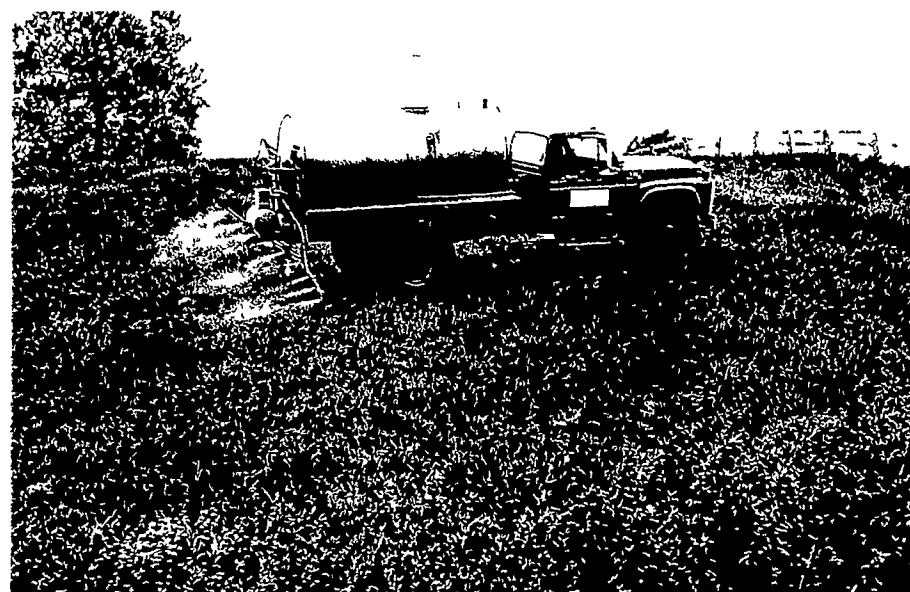

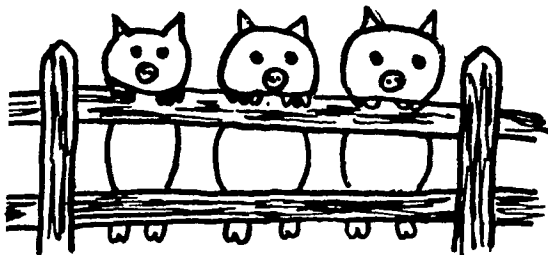
